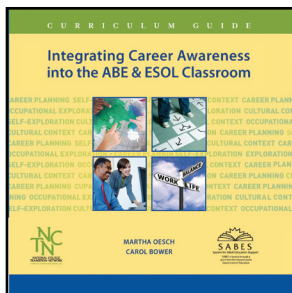
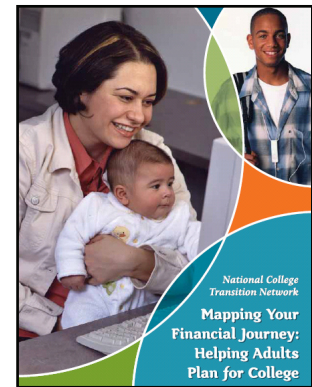


The College Transition Toolkit (CD)
